finding that courage commitment is at the core of social life the social fabric is woven from promises and threats that are not always immediately advantageous to the parties involved many commitments such as signing a contract are fairly straightforward deals in which both parties agree to give up certain options other commitments such as the promise of life long love or a threat of murder are based on more intangible factors such as human emotions in evolution and the capacity for commitment distinguished researchers from the fields of economics psychology ethology anthropology philosophy medicine and law offer a rich variety of perspectives on the nature of commitment and question whether the capacity for making assessing and keeping commitments has been shaped by natural selection game theorists have shown that players who use commitment strategies by learning to convey subjective offers and to gauge commitments others are willing to make achieve greater success than those who rationally calculate every move for immediate reward evolution and the capacity for commitment includes contributions from some of the pioneering students of commitment their elegant analyses highlight the critical role of reputation building and show the importance of investigating how people can believe that others would carry out promises or threats that go against their own self loyalty in management signifies a person s devotion or sentiment of attachment to a particular object which may be another person or an organization it expresses itself in both thought and action and strives for the identification of the interests of the loyal person with those of the organization employee loyalty in the other hand can be defined as employees being committed to the success of the organization and believing that working for this particular organization is in their best option organizational commitment is a psychological state that characterizes the employee s relationships with the organization and has implications for the decision to continue working in that organization this paper is based on an exploratory study with a purpose to gain an understanding on the antecedents determining loyalty and commitment in the business environment the aim of this empirical study was to gauge antecedents for employee loyalty and commitment in the south west region of cameroon the research was conducted in this anglophone region of cameroon among lower and middle managers of both public and private organizations the respondents were purposely chosen to ease the research during a cross sectional study data was collected from 300 employees with the age ranging from 25 to 50 years questionnaire was administered using five point likert scale result shows that the correlational and stepwise regression analyses revealed a number of significant relationships between the main variables in addition the covariance based structural equation modeling cb sem and partial least squares sem pls sem used matched statistical techniques for estimating structural equation models showed that there are a number of antecedents impacting employees loyalty and commitment in the work place finally recommendations were made for an effective and efficient policies aiming at reaching employees commitment and loyalty in the workplace
